

## RECOMMENDED BILLING AND CODING GUIDANCE

**The following list(s) of procedure and diagnosis codes is for reference purposes only and may not be all-inclusive.**

**The CPT modifier 33 is used to identify medical care whose primary purpose is delivering an evidence-based preventative service based on recommendations of the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force. Use of modifier 33 will allow your patients with commercial insurance to access \$0 coverage for preventive services.**

*Medicare and Medicaid do not recognize modifier 33.*

*Medicare requires the use of dedicated G codes.*

**Modifier 90 should be used when laboratory procedures are performed by a party other than the treating or reporting physician and the laboratory bills the physician for the service**

86701 HIV antibody test performed (HIV-1 only)

86703 HIV antibody test performed (HIV-1 and HIV-2)

Infectious Agent Antigen Detection

87389 HIV-1 EIA antibody with HIV1&2 antigens

87390 HIV-1 detection by immunoassay (IAAD EIA HIV-1)

Antiretroviral Therapy Administration:

96372 (Administration)
